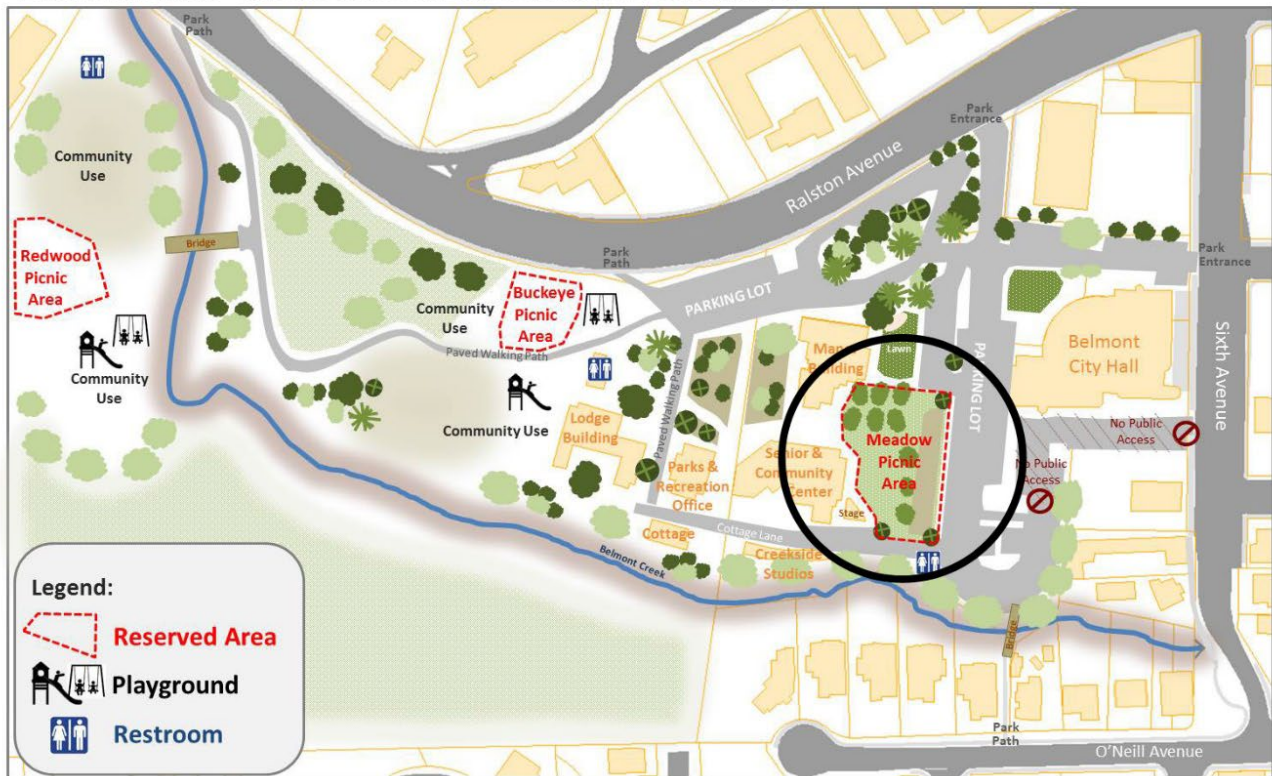

Izzy- Is a young female, schnauzer-Westie (or maybe maltese-Westie) mix. She is about 11 months old. She is working on being house trained and leash trained and learning to be a good canine citizen. She is a sweet girl. She is just 11 lbs. She likes toys and going for walks with her adopted dad. She is very playful. Izzy has been adopted.



Logan – Logan is a very sweet boy who is about 2 years old. He has skin issues which are being treated. He is otherwise a healthy boy. He loves to play and gets along with other dogs. He is housetrained but doesn't like going out in the rain. He wants his breakfast! Logan has been adopted.



Emi - Emi is a sweet playful little 2 year old girl. We think she and Logan are littermates. She is a healthy girl. Emi is very affectionate and loving. She has been adopted.



Archie Update- Archie has made exceptional progress since coming to rescue. Although he is still cautious, his behavior has improved. Archie has been adopted.

Tony came to rescue in 2015 as a volunteer as WRAP was being organized. He was instrumental in setting up our first website and Facebook page. He fostered several dogs and also adopted a breeder dog named Christy. Tony loved all his dogs, Westie and non-Westie alike.

Tony grew up on the east coast and spent several years as a child in Greece. He loved Greek food and liked to cook. He liked living in San Francisco and was there over 30 years. Although he had several health issues we are not clear on the cause of death. He died suddenly on the morning of April 8th, 2024, shortly before his 68th birthday.
